Frankston Public Art Maintenance Plan

Brecknock Consulting, in association with Peter Maxwell from Maxim Consulting Services, recently completed a Public Art Maintenance Plan for Frankston City Council's artwork collection. The project involved undertaking a detailed conservation audit of the City's entire public art collection. The audit consisted of a review of the current condition of each work, 57 in total, and recommended conservation. Following the audit our team prepared a asset management strategy which involved developing a detailed condition recording and reporting spreadsheet systems. The plan provides Council with a conservation assessment of both urgently needed conservation and restoration work and an annual program of maintenance requirements.
